*Intro (slowly):*

E C G A7

*Verse 1:*

D G

E7 A7

*(play next line slowly):*

"Nine" and "ten": Benign and tender, we pitch woo.

*Verse 3:*

D G  
I could go on this way for- ever.  
E A  
'cause I know that I can always count on you.  
D7 Gbar  
But I guess it best I wrap up this en- deavor  
E7 A7 D  
At "eleven, 'cause— hey babe— I'm a-lovin you.
