REVIEW TEAM GUIDELINES

As the syllabus explained, you will each have the opportunity to earn 10 class participation points by serving on a team of students tasked to review the prior classes's content. Please see below for your team assignment. Here are the requirements for you to receive those 10 points:

- 1) You will start the class *after* the one you've been assigned by orally reviewing the substance of the *prior* class. You should expect to receive questions from your audience.
- 2) By or before 10 a.m. of the day of your oral presentation, you should send to my administrative assistant, Frank Alvarado, a written summary of your review. You can email Frank at: falvarad@chapman.edu.
- 3) Your written review should be in Word format (to allow subsequent editing) and no longer than one page long. You need not worry about distributing copies to your colleagues; Frank and I will take care of that.
- 4) You must give part of your team's oral presentation to receive any points for the project. That means, of course, that you must be present. Excuses for showing up too late, or not at all, will avail you nothing on that count.

Assuming that you in good faith satisfy those criteria, you will receive 10 class participation points; if not, then zero points.
